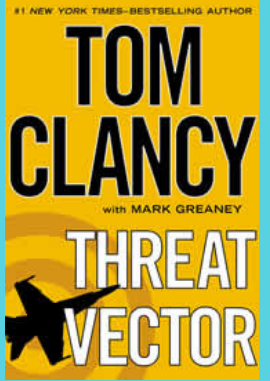





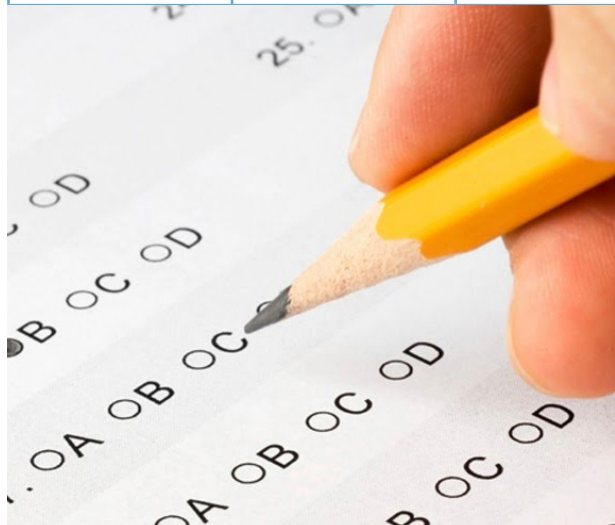

The Importance of ACT Practice Test

A 2012 study conducted by the ACT found that the higher that ACT score the higher their freshman year GPA. Students with a higher freshman year GPA are more likely to graduate from college. ACT practice tests, if taken properly, will clearly map the areas of strengths and weaknesses in the five subjects included on the test, therefore allowing students to focus on problem areas. ACT practice tests makes the students aware of the different styles of questions as well as the different subject areas on the test. Through the Alabama Public Library Service website, WCPL can provide students with a test prep called Learning Express Library. This educational website allows students to take numerous practice test as well as refresher courses on individual subjects where help is needed. 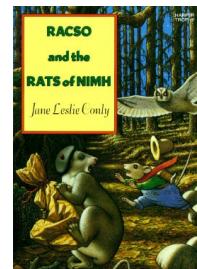


BOOK CLUB *A Year of Classics*
